

Upgrading Software on 100x

Connect a PC to LAN port of 100x, select “Obtain an IP address automatically” in Internet Protocol Properties and save settings on the PC. Open a web browser, type 192.168.123.1 in address box and press enter key to get in 100x box.

Click **Download** on the left side to go to Download page.
